



GET READY!

Place a towel on your work table so that if you drop a bead it won't bounce off the table. Arrange your beads, stretchy string and ribbons on top of the towel. Have handy some clear tape or masking tape and a pair of scissors.

GET SET!

Cut a length of string that is about 6" long for a ring, 10" long for a bracelet or 18" long for a necklace. Use the ruler here to measure your lengths.

Put a piece of clear tape or masking tape onto the end of the string so your beads won't fall off.

Place the beading needle on the string and bead away! Make up different color combinations, patterns, or mix them all up!

After you have beaded about 2" for a ring, 7" for a bracelet or 17" for a necklace, check the length so that it is the perfect fit. Adjust the amount of beads on the string if necessary.

When you have the length you want, slip the beading needle and tape off the string and tie the loose ends together close to your beads. Be sure to pull the knot good and tight.

GO!

Now you can add a decorative bow! Cut a 4" piece and tie it around your jewelry. Trim the ends of the ribbon so they look tidy and straight.

Make a bunch and wear them all together!
